Del.icio.us and/or Diigo – sites used to create online bookmarks that others can view		Wiki - piece of server software that allows users to freely create and edit Web page content using any Web browser
Blog's - A weblog is a journal (or newsletter) that is frequently updated and intended for general public consumption.		Flickr – secure online photo management and sharing application
Podcast - a method for delivering multimedia, such as audio or video, over the Internet		YouTube – video sharing website, students can load videos to link to their site
Evernote / Google+ – online organizational website, where the user can create “to-do” list, calendars, gather information for a research project, etc.
